



Meeting Minutes for Wenesday, January 13, 2010 6:45 p.m.

Open Issues:

- Heather brought up the idea of the Club having a banner with our logo on it to have at competitions, parades and display during fundraising. The company that makes our jackets, Jammin' quoted \$65-\$75 for it to be made. All in attendance agreed it was a worthy purchase.
- We are still waiting to hear back from Jerry Santoferrara (skating director) about whether or not we can hold an ISI competition at the Centre Ice Rink sometime in the spring or early summer.
- It has been brought to our attention that the Centre Ice Rink/DE State Fair wants the BCFSC to present the Spring ice show. They will continue to organize the Christmas shows but if the Club wants to have a Spring show each year we will have to be responsible for putting it on. This means the Club will be buying the ice time, coaches, scenery/props, posters/programs, gifts for guest skaters etc. There will be a Public Forum of sorts on Friday, January 22nd at 7:00 p.m. to see if there is interest from LTS parents/kids and Club members. It was decided we must have at least 50 skaters in the show and massive parental support to pull this off.
- We will have another board meeting next Wednesday, Jan. 20th at 6:30 to get ready for Friday's public forum.
